Anaheim Campus Security reports that at approximately 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 23, 2012, an Anaheim Campus female student was approached by a male suspect in a truck who spoke to her and then exposed himself to her. The incident occurred as the female was walking westbound, toward the campus from Euclid Avenue, on the Romneya Drive sidewalk. The victim ran away and immediately informed her counselor who contacted Campus Security. The Anaheim Police was then called and an incident report was taken.

No one was injured in the incident.

The victim described the suspect as follows:

- Male, Hispanic, approximately 40-45 years old, medium complexion, thin mustache, bushy eyebrows and spoke with an accent.

The victim described the car as follows:

- Older, grey pick-up truck with a hand-made, wooden, crate-like shell in the back of the truck that contained gardening tools.

Anyone with additional information, or who may see someone matching this description, is asked to contact the Anaheim Campus Security at 714-808-4911.

Thanks to the campus community for their quick and responsive action to this situation. Anaheim Campus Security and the Anaheim Police Department are on alert and will continue to closely monitor the campus. Students, staff and faculty are reminded to walk in groups, seek the assistance of someone trustworthy, and utilize Campus Safety escorts.
